## Environmental Policy Statement

Allgood is the UK's leading architectural ironmonger in the supply of products for commercial and public buildings. Allgood covers every aspect of door furniture, hardware and access control.

Allgood recognises the responsibility it has to reduce the negative effect the company's business activities have on the environment. Its Centralised Distribution Centre (CDC) has developed an Environmental Management System (EMS) to meet the requirements of BS EN ISO14001:2004 to reinforce the following commitments:

- Commitment to operate in accordance with all applicable environmental legislation and other requirements to which the site subscribes.
- Commitment to prevention of pollution from site activities and actions. The CDC will ensure that all activities carrying a risk of pollution in any form are identified and either eliminated, or controlled effectively through the adoption of appropriate control methods.
- Commitment to continual improvement and the setting of objectives and targets to drive continual improvement. The EMS will be used as a vehicle for the setting, measuring and monitoring environmental performance to ensure success of environmental objectives. Objectives will be reviewed on an annual basis.

The CDC will continue to target a reduction in electricity and material consumption and monitor usage across the site to establish a baseline for improving site efficiencies.

The CDC will take account of concerns of interested parties such as regulators, shareholders, employees and the public, ensuring these are recorded and dealt with promptly.

The CDC will ensure that all people that work for and on behalf of the organisation are aware of this policy and are trained in their environmental responsibilities.

The CDC supports the adoption of similar standards and commitment by its customers and suppliers.

Copies of this policy statement are freely available to the public and other interested bodies via its web site.

This Policy will be implemented within the framework of our environmental management system which will be regularly audited and independently assessed. The policy will be reviewed annually, and amendments may be made as stipulated by legislation, changes in company activities or external requirements.
