

Mann Island - Case Study

Mann Island is where cutting edge architecture and modern urban living meet English history. Situated at the heart of the Liverpool docklands, the £45 million 'Building 3' was built for commercial use and has since been leased by Mersey Travel.

The UNESCO world heritage site was once the starting point for millions of emigrants on their journey to the 'new world' countries of America, Australia & New Zealand.

Now an architectural hotspot, Mann island has become one of Liverpool's most vibrant and upcoming areas. Comprising of office space and apartments, the waterfront development attracts over 25,000 visitors per day alone.
